

## Capillary electrophoresis and the sequencing of the human genome

The completion of the sequencing of the human genome represented a revolution in biology--our complete genetic heritage has now been available for two decades. The determination of this sequence was the result of several scientific advances, including whole-genome shotgun sequencing, sophisticated bioinformatic algorithms, and capillary array DNA sequencing instruments. This talk reviews the development of capillary array electrophoresis technology that made this revolution in genomics possible.
